Development of Ageing Policies and Long Term Care Services in China

Ageing policies and the elderly care service system is of great necessity to meet the rapid population ageing in China. Based on the existing research and practice, this presentation will introduce the recent development of major strategy, policies and practices on national provincial level. The governance of ageing society has been developed as the guideline to integrate the existing efforts. In view of the imbalance between urban and rural development, and the inefficiency of service integration and delivery faced by the elderly care service in China, the policy suggestions propose that China should clarify the main key stakeholders of the elderly care in China, achieve sustainable and balanced development, encourage sustainable care and community home care, develop a reasonable financing system, and establish professional industry standards and talent team for further development.



Prof. Du Peng is Vice-President of Renmin University of China, Director and Professor of the Institute of Gerontology, Renmin University of China. His academic titles include Vice-President, China Gerontology and Geriatrics Society; Vice-President of China Population Association. He has been the member of Experts in Committee, the Ministry of Civil Affairs (since 2006), board member of Help Age International (2008–2016) and board member of United Nations International Institute on Ageing (since 2008). He also served as the chair of International Association of Gerontology and Geriatrics Asia/Oceania Region from 2009 to 2013. His research interests are population ageing and ageing policies. His publications include: *The Process of Population Ageing in China*, *The Older Persons in China*, *Social Gerontology*, *Who will support the Older Persons*, *Ageing Issues and Policies in EU Countries*, *Population Ageing and Ageing Issues*, *Population Ageing: Changes and Challenges*, *Disabled Persons and Their Social Protection in Rural China*, *China's Population in the 21st Century*, *Ageing Society and Harmonious Society*, *The Value of Older People*.
