Baseline Household ID is the Wave 1 Household ID (assigned during sampling), and it will be carried along to all the subsequent waves. It is to be autopopulated. Wave 2 Household ID (sequential interview ID) will be assigned by the CAPI when the actual Wave 2 interview starts.

#### **Household Information**

#### "Household Members":

- 1. Refer to persons living together in the same house.
- 2. Include family members who live in this household unit and are related through blood/marriage/adoption;
- 3. Include family members who are currently absent for a short period of time (for <u>no more</u> than 3 months) because of temporary commitments (e.g., schooling, serving in the army, work, or other reasons), and will return to and stay in the household for the long term;
- 4. Also include other relatives and non-relatives (such as foreign domestic workers and tenants) who live in the household unit.

#### "Primary Caregiver (PCG)" is:

A household member who takes primary responsibility for the child(ren). By preference, PCG is usually the child's mother (biological, adoptive, step, or foster). If the mother is not living with the child, the PCG could be the father (biological, adoptive, step, or foster), or the legal guardian of the target child(ren). Final preference is an adult (over 18 years of age) living in this household unit and knows most about the child's activities; and this does <u>not</u> include someone who is paid or hired to take care of the child (i.e. <u>not</u> a domestic helper).

#### "Head of Household" is:

The household member who is generally acknowledged as the head by other members of the household. The head is normally the main income earner, the oldest, the owner-occupier of the house or the person who manages the affairs of the household.
