GUIDELINES

The placement test is required if you:

- Are able to read and write/type Hiragana and Katakana and form simple sentences; OR
- Have prior knowledge of the Japanese language acquired through formal or informal means. Examples include, but not limited to:
 - o Study of the language as part of your formal school curriculum;
 - o Courses taken at private language institutions;
 - Acquisition of the language through ethnic or family background (e.g. from parents);
 - Self-study

Please take the placement test **ONLY** if you are seriously planning to read an LAJ course <u>this semester</u>. The result and waiver are only valid for one semester. Please ensure that there is no timetable clash and, especially for Year 1 students, do check whether there is ample time to read an LAJ course with your home faculty.
