## *Description of the Korean Language Programme*

Korean has emerged as one of the most globally influential languages in the 21st century, extending its impact across technology, business, diplomacy, popular culture, and transnational collaboration, thereby making proficiency in Korean an increasingly valuable intellectual and professional asset.

At the National University of Singapore, the Korean Language Programme offers a carefully structured curriculum that progresses systematically from foundational to advanced levels, enabling students not only to acquire grammatical knowledge and vocabulary, but also to develop the communicative agility and cultural awareness required to function effectively in diverse Korean-speaking environments.

The programme is distinguished by its research-informed design, its emphasis on active student engagement, and its commitment to developing learners who are confident, reflective, and globally competent.

No prior knowledge of Korean is required for entry into Level 1.

### **Our Signature Pedagogical Approach: The Flipped Classroom Model**

Rather than adopting a conventional lecture-centred format in which students passively receive information during class time and struggle to apply it independently afterward, the Korean Language Programme employs a flipped classroom model that redefines how instructional time is structured and utilised.

Under this model, students are first introduced to essential grammatical concepts, vocabulary sets, and cultural materials through carefully curated online resources before attending class, thereby allowing valuable in-person time to be devoted to higher-order application, interaction, and guided practice.

## *Structure of the Language Programme*

The Korean language programme currently consists of eight courses of different levels:

<b>Elementary Level:</b>	Korean 1, Korean 2
<b>Intermediate Level:</b>	Korean 3, Korean 4
<b>Advanced Level:</b>	Korean 5, Korean 6

Class sessions are deliberately structured as dynamic environments in which students actively construct knowledge through communicative practice rather than passively absorb information through extended explanation.
