## GUIDELINES

The placement test is required if you:

- Are able to read and write/type Hiragana and Katakana and form simple sentences; OR
- Have prior knowledge of the Japanese language acquired through formal or informal means. Examples include, but not limited to:
  - Study of the language as part of your formal school curriculum – this includes approved course mappings for NUS students;
  - Courses taken at private language institutions;
  - Acquisition of the language through ethnic or family background (e.g. from parents);
  - Self-study
