	 c. The Scholarship recipient must be successfully admitted to the MA by research or PhD programme (full-time) at the Department of Chinese Studies, NUS.
	 d. The Scholarship will be awarded based on academic performance. Applicants must have obtained a CAP (Cumulative Average Point) of at least 4.0 (or equivalent) in their Honours or equivalent degree in Chinese Studies or relevant discipline.
	 e. Students who are granted NUS Research Scholarship/Tuition Fee Allowance or appointed a Graduate Teaching/Research/Assistant Fellow are eligible for the Scholarship. However, students in receipt of any other scholarship/fellowship/financial award cannot concurrently hold the Wan
	Boo Sow Graduate Scholarship in Chinese Studies. f. The Scholarship recipient's studies and thesis must be related to specialized research in all aspects of Chinese language, literature, history, philosophy and culture. Research in Chinese culture in Southeast Asia is encouraged.

Conditions	 a. The Department Scholarship Selection Committee, comprising the Head (Committee Chair) or his nominee and the Department Graduate Coordinator, will shortlist, interview and award the Scholarship. b. No scholarship will be awarded unless there is a candidate of sufficient merit.
