

The Chinese Studies Major Scholarship

1. The Scholarship takes effect from the AY2021/2022 cohort.
2. Application is open to the following students:
 - (a) All incoming NUS students who intend to major in Chinese Studies (CH) and/or Chinese Language (CL).
 - (b) All Year 1 to Year 3 (Semester 1) NUS students who are majoring in CH and/or CL. (Call for application will be conducted at the start of every semester.)
3. The main selection criterion for the scholarship interviews will be the academic scores or equivalent of the applicants. Leadership potential and good character of the applicants will also be considered by the interview panel.
4. The total value of the Scholarship is determined by the academic plan that students have declared:

5. Students are expected to keep track of individual fulfilment of the Scholarship requirements once awarded the Scholarship. At the end of each semester, students must have (a) declared major(s) in CH and/or CL, (b) fulfilled course requirements and (c) attained GPA of at least 3.5, before they can apply to Department of Chinese Studies for disbursements. Disbursement structure is shown below:

6. For continuation of the Scholarship, students are required to continue majoring in CH and/or CL and meet Scholarship requirements, failing which will result in suspension or termination of the Scholarship.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

7. Students who are offered admission to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course at NUS and intend to major in CH and/or CL will be eligible to apply. Subject to (1) mentioned above, matriculated NUS students who are majoring in CH and/or CL may also apply during Year 1 to Year 3 (Semester 1) of their course of study.
8. Students must not concurrently hold any other awards such as scholarships, grants, bursaries or free aid, without the prior approval of the FASS Scholarship Selection Committee as well as the respective awarding bodies.
