

The Department of Chinese Studies Major Scholarships

1. Application is open to the following students:
 - (a) All incoming NUS students (Cohort 2026 onwards) who intend to major in Chinese Languages and Cultures (CL) and/or Chinese Studies (Bilingual) (CH).
 - (b) Current Year 1 to Year 3 NUS students who are majoring in CL and/or CH. (Call for applications will be conducted in June every year.)
2. The main selection criterion for the scholarship interviews will be the academic scores or equivalent of the applicants. Leadership potential and good character of the applicants will also be considered by the interview panel.
3. The Scholarship will be disbursed over multiple semesters, based on the milestones achieved by the students throughout their course of study. The payout for achieving one milestone is \$5,000. The total value of the Scholarship is determined by the academic plan that students have declared:

4. Students are expected to keep track of individual fulfilment of the Scholarship requirements once awarded the Scholarship. At the end of each semester, students must have (a) declared major(s) in CH and/or CL, (b) fulfilled course requirements, (c) attained GPA of at least 3.5, and (d) not violated NUS Code of Student Conduct before they can apply to the Department of Chinese Studies for disbursements.
5. For continuation of the Scholarship, students are required to continue majoring in CL and/or CH and meet Scholarship requirements, failing which will result in suspension or termination of the Scholarship.
6. Students must not concurrently hold any other awards such as scholarships, grants, bursaries or free aid, without prior approval of the Scholarship Selection Committee as well as the respective awarding bodies.
7. The Department of Chinese Studies reserves the right to not award any scholarship if there are no candidates of sufficient merit. The decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee is final. Enquiries or disputes surrounding its decisions will not be entertained.
