**Lecturer/Senior Lecturer in Geographic Information Science (Educator Track)**

The Department of Geography at the National University of Singapore invites applications for a Lecturer/Senior Lecturer position on the Educator Track. The track aims to attract, nurture, and retain suitably qualified and highly effective faculty members who approach teaching as scholarly practice, and who therefore focus on and are passionate about excellence in teaching as a means of supporting student learning. The appointment will begin in July 2020 or as soon as possible thereafter for a period of three years with the possibility of extension.

The candidate who should have a keen interest in teaching modules in GIS, must have a PhD at the time of the appointment. The ability to teach advanced level of GIS modules (e.g. Internet Geography, Spatial analysis of big data) and conduct pedagogical and disciplinary research will be an advantage. Preference will be given to candidates who are able to combine their GIS expertise with a relevant area of research in the social sciences (e.g. economics and finance, health and well-being, urban informatics and smart cities).

The successful applicant will be required to contribute at least two modules in the Department's MSc Applied GIS Programme (<http://www.fas.nus.edu.sg/geog/graduate/msc-in-applied-gis.html>), in addition to contributing to teaching in at least two other undergraduate modules.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The appointee (according to whether s/he is a Singaporean, permanent resident of Singapore or other nationality) may also enjoy some or all of the following benefits: subsidised housing, medical and leave benefits and relocation assistance.

Application review will begin on 16 September 2019 until a suitable candidate is identified. Candidates should send the following documents with their letter of application:

- Full curriculum vitae
- Teaching statement
- Teaching evaluation if available
- Brief research statement
- Names and contact details of three referees
