have the appropriate skills. The job scope will include, but is not limited to, assisting

lecturers with module organization, set up and co-teaching of laboratory and tutorial

sessions and grading of assignments and exams. This position will involve substantial

interaction with students.

successful candidate will be encouraged to apply for postgraduate courses in the

Department of Geography and to pursue lifelong learning opportunities available for NUS

staff and alumni.
