700 Years surveys the visual arts to tell a *long* and *connected* history of Singapore's engagement with the region and the world from the 9th to the 19th centuries. It draws on Singapore's museums and archives to examine objects ranging from mass-produced ceramics and textiles to bespoke paintings and manuscripts. The course adopts foundational art historical methods with technology-integrated and innovative pedagogies to offer a flexible and blended educational experience to an NUS and worldwide learner base.

From August 2026, *700 Years* will be offered as an undergraduate blended learning course and from January 2027 as a Continuing Education and Training (CET) offering. We have organised this launch event to thank all our museum partners and to familiarise potential learners with the course.
