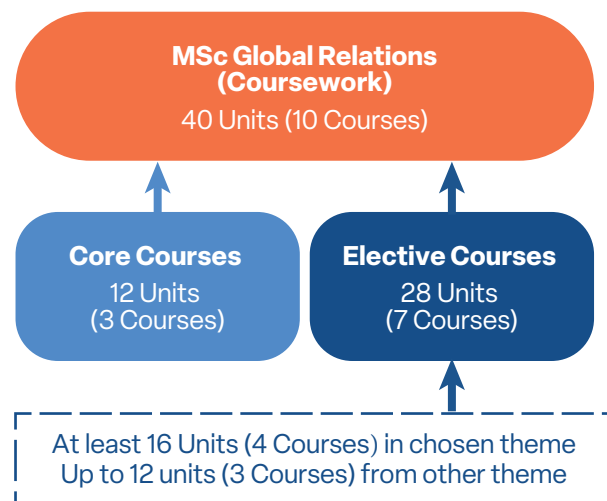

Admission Requirements



- An NUS Honours degree (Merit/Second Class and above) or equivalent (e.g., a four-year Bachelor's degree with at least an average grade of B) in a relevant discipline; or
- A Bachelor's Degree (preferably with Honors: Merit/Second Class and above)
- A Bachelor's degree with a relevant Graduate Diploma with a minimum GPA of 3.00; or
- A Bachelor's degree with a relevant Graduate Certificate with a minimum GPA of 3.00; or
- A Bachelor's degree in a relevant discipline and at least 2 years of relevant work experience; or
- Other qualifications and experience subject to approval by the Graduate Studies Division, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.
