

Suggested Psychology Study Plans for Cohort 2019-2020

These study plans assume you are a Psychology Single Major Honours, Psychology Single Major or Psychology Second Major. While you can read any psychology module as long as you meet the pre-requisites, the logical path is to complete the introductory content and first methods modules before you proceed to the core and second methods modules. After obtaining a broad overview of the major domains and methods of the discipline from the compulsory modules, you can move on to the electives – more specialised content and empirical modules. For honours students, the capstones, as the name implies, should only be done in your final year. The curriculum chart attached gives an overview of how the undergraduate curriculum flows from first to fourth year.

Majoring in Psychology (Single Major)

- PL1101E and PL2131 should ideally be read in your first year, as shown in Table 1A. However, these modules are always in great demand, but there is no need to panic if you aren't able to read both in your first year. Table 1B shows that even if you can only complete them in your third semester, you can still fulfil the psychology requirements comfortably.
- PL2132 and the five core modules (PL3232/PL3102 - PL3206/3106) should ideally be read in your second year.
- The lab module and 3000-level electives should only be read in your third year.
- Your final year should be reserved solely for your capstone modules and the other 4000-level electives.
- The above should apply even when you embark on a student exchange programme. You can map all core and elective modules except PL1101E, PL2131, PL2132, and the lab modules.

Majoring in Psychology (Second Major)

- PL1101E and PL2131 should ideally be read in your first year, as shown in Table 2A. However, these modules are always in great demand, but there is no need to panic if you aren't able to read both in your first year. Table 2B shows that even if you can only complete them in your third semester, you can still fulfil the psychology requirements comfortably.
- PL2132 and the five core modules (PL3232/PL3102 - PL3206/3106) should ideally be read in your second year.
- The above should apply even when you embark on a student exchange programme. You can map all core and elective modules except PL1101E, PL2131 and PL2132.

Minoring in Psychology

The ModReg system prioritises majors, so you may have difficulty getting into the core modules. The recommended approach is to read one module per semester, as shown in Table 3A, but if you cannot get in, it is still possible to complete the minor if you read two per semester from your fourth semester onwards, as shown in Table 3B.
