The inaugural **NUS Health and Wellbeing (HWB) Scholarship** is designed to attract talented clinical psychologists to embark on a meaningful career in the NUS Health and Wellbeing department. The scholarship is open to students enrolled in the Master of Psychology (Clinical) programme in the NUS Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (FASS). Successful applicants will take on the role of a **Wellbeing Specialist Partner (Clinical Psychologist)** upon graduation, and contribute to efforts to enhance the wellbeing of our NUS community.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

- Be a Singaporean Citizen or Permanent Resident (PR)
- Be enrolled in NUS Master of Psychology (Clinical) Programme
- Have a strong interest in serving the NUS Community
- Have a strong interest in innovating the way mental health is enhanced in a workplace and on campus
- Display curiosity and a willingness to embrace broad skills in tackling challenges of a VUCA world
- Not be serving any current bond or scholarship
- Successfully complete interview/selection rounds with the HWB Team

SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

- Full tuition fee coverage for entire duration of study
- Stipend of up to S\$1,500/month (up to S\$36,000 over 2 years of study)
- One-time bonus of S\$18,000 upon confirmation of appointment as Wellbeing Specialist Partner (Clinical Psychologist)
- Medical insurance coverage

CONDITIONS

Successful applicants will be required to sign an agreement to serve NUS for a bond period of **two years**, upon successful completion of the Master's degree within the stipulated time.
