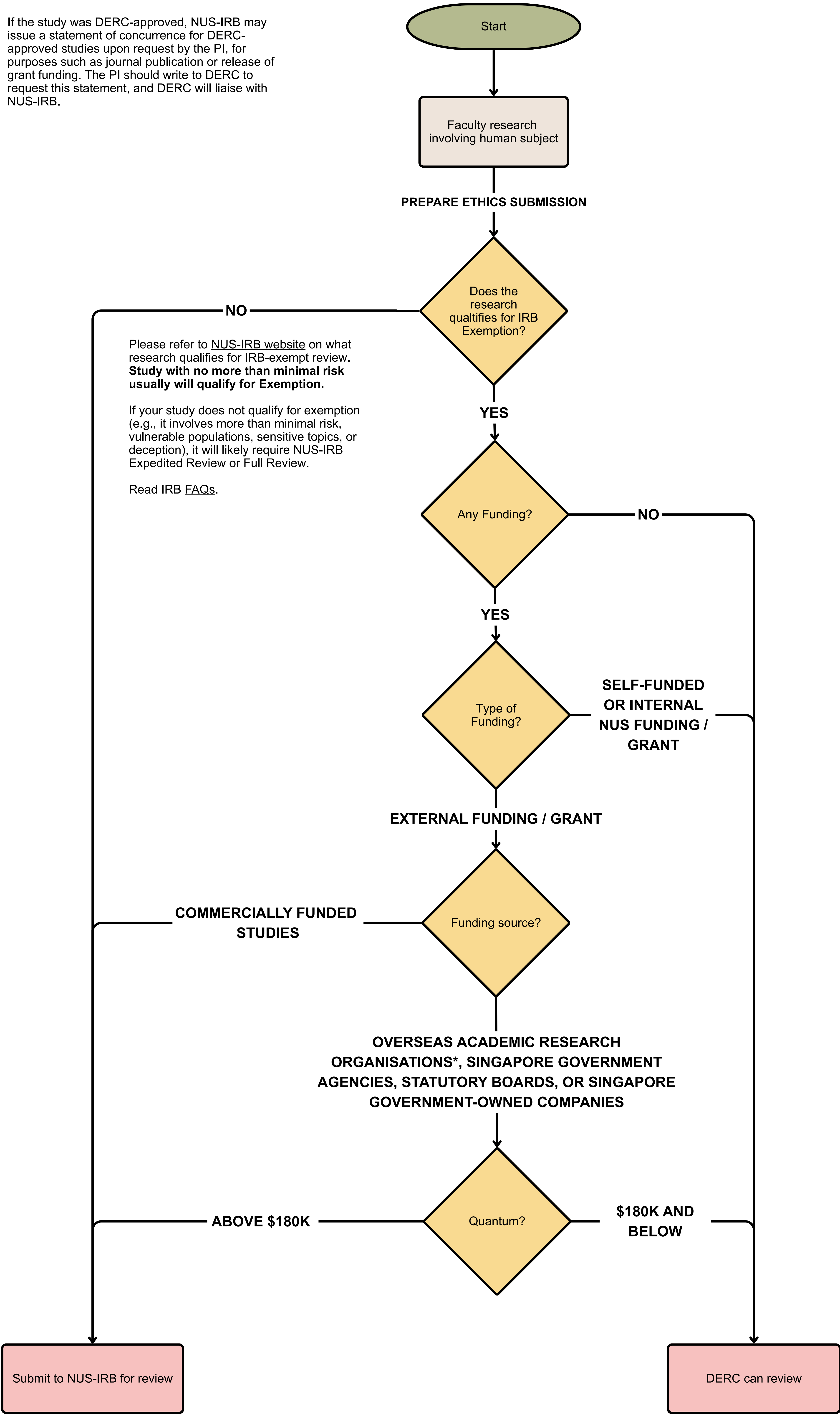


Faculty Research Projects

All DERC submission is to be made via [DREAM](#).
All NUS-IRB submission is to be made via [iRIMS](#).

Note:

If the study was DERC-approved, NUS-IRB may issue a statement of concurrence for DERC-approved studies upon request by the PI, for purposes such as journal publication or release of grant funding. The PI should write to DERC to request this statement, and DERC will liaise with NUS-IRB.



*Overseas academic research organizations generally include non-profit research foundations such as the Wellcome Trust, Howard Hughes Medical Institute, Max Planck Institutes, the Gates Foundation, Russell Sage Foundation, or Thyssen Foundation, as well as overseas (pan-)national research foundations such as Horizon Europe.

For faculty research, DERC review may be possible for no funding, self-funding, internal NUS funding, or certain permitted public/academic external funding up to \$180,000, provided all other DERC criteria are met.

MOE Tier 1-funded faculty research is generally treated as external funding, but it may still be DERC-reviewable if the amount is up to \$180,000 and all other DERC criteria are satisfied.
