Information is a source of learning. But unless it is organized, processed, and available to the right people in a format for decision making, it is a burden, not a benefit” – William Pollard.

In clinical practice, there is a compelling need to organize information gleaned from the therapeutic process to organize for relevant insights and support for our clients. This four-day Intermediate Training (28 hours) is the second core skills training in Gestalt Play Therapy. Designed for those who have completed the Basic Training in Gestalt Play Therapy, the workshop will build on theoretical, skill development and clinical practice from the Gestalt approach with emphasis on developing robust assessment, diagnosis and plans. Balancing didactic discussion, experiential practicum with feedback, and case presentations, participants will learn key concepts and skills that will enhance their therapeutic practice with their clients.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

At the end of training, the participants will

- Understand the principles of Gestalt Therapy and how it is adapted for use in the Oaklander Model
- Frame observations and formulations in the Gestalt framework
- Develop a clinical formulation based on the Oaklander Model
- Practice making assessments and treatment plans using case studies given

PRE-REQUISITE:

Attended a prior workshop on Basic Training in Gestalt Play Therapy or the equivalent.
