About the Course

Which leadership approaches are aligned with social work values? What are some core skills a new leader needs to develop to build a thriving team? This introductory leadership course will equip participants with skills that build greater courage and confidence in oneself to lead with wisdom and care.

At the end of the course, participants will be able to:

- 1. Articulate how leadership can help them have a greater impact on more lives and contribute to their own learning and growth.
- 2. Cultivate skills to transition to leadership with greater ease and confidence.
- 3.Outline at least one leadership approach that is aligned with social work values such as service to humanity, social justice, dignity and worth of the person, importance of human relationships and integrity (which are adopted by the Singapore Association of Social Workers) and a few skills related to it.
- 4. Develop communication and relationship skills that bring out the best in others.
- 5. Develop skills to manage meetings more effectively so that high value conversations take place.

Who Should Attend

This course is targeted at new and emerging supervisors/managers and any others in leadership positions in the social service sector who are keen to learn more about such leadership approaches.

Other Information

- 1.It's recommended for organisations to send at least two staff members to increase chances of actively practicing what is taught during the course.
- 2.There will be pre-course materials given and participants are expected to complete them before day 1 of the course.
- 3. There will be work required to be done between day 1 and day 2 of course.
- 4. All participants are expected to be physically and mentally present, and participate with their videos and mics switched on from a quiet, uninterrupted space.
- 5.All participants are expected be physically present for the assessment conducted towards the end of Day 2.
