Developmental Play is a pioneering approach that ensures children have the fundamentals in place for their cognitive, physical, social and emotional growth, built on the idea that as children grow they need to do different kinds of play. This foundational course allows you to study the theory and practice of play based on the Essame Developmental Play Pyramid. It will show why play matters, how it works and give you a solid foundation in the role of play to support the holistic development of children. Developmental Play is associated with a global drive to bring play back into childhood, and this course forms the first part of a three-part certificate endorsed by the World Federation of Occupational Therapists.

Learning Objectives

1. Understand and identify developmental play stages.
2. Understand attachment theory and why children need relationships with objects.
3. Understand the developmental play pyramid.
4. Understand the importance of working with mess in child development.

This course is targeted at Social Workers and all helping professionals who work with children and youths to improve their social integration, growth and development, emotional modulation and trauma resolution.
