

Stephen Riady Social Work Student Stipend Award

Social Work major students are required to complete two field placements to fulfill graduation requirements, and are provided with an allowance to help defray the daily expenses that the students incur during field placements, such as food and travel expenses. The Stipend Award will help to supplement Social Work students' field placement allowance.

The Award will be open to all undergraduate Social Work major students, and will be given to as many eligible students undertaking field placement as possible subject to the availability of funds.

The Award will be given out starting from FY2019.

Application Period

There is no application period. A Committee will select top students undertaking field placement to receive the Award.

Value of Award

The Award is a one-time award of S\$225 per student per year and the value of Award may be adjusted accordingly.

Disbursement

The Award will be given to the students in November.

Eligibility

The selection criteria will be based on merit. Students must meet the following eligibility conditions:

- Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident;
- Completed a field placement with a grade of A- and above; and
- Obtained a grade of A- and above for field educator's evaluation in a field placement.
