ABOUT THE COURSE

Aims to equip social workers with knowledge and skills to manage clients with common mental health conditions and complex psycho-social presentations.

AT THE END OF THE COURSE, PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO:

1. Conduct family casework involving common mental health conditions, collaborating in a multi and transdisciplinary context, towards relapse prevention and mental health recovery;
2. Apply the Integrated Illness Causation Model in mental health casework with complex psychosocial problems;
3. Provide psycho-education to clients and their families about mental wellness, mental illness and treatment; and supporting families in their caregiving roles; and
4. Apply relevant legislations and ethical practice in mental health social work.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This course is targeted at social workers, case managers and community-based counsellors in the medical and social sectors who:

1. Have at least 3 years of experience working with clients with common mental health conditions;
2. Preferably, have attended basic mental health education at the undergraduate level, mental health first aid training, or the Foundational Module in Mental Health with NUS SW Department, etc.
