Sino Suisse Internship Grant

The Sino Suisse Internship Grant was established by the Sino Suisse Private Wealth Management to support Social Work students who are on internships/placements working with youth-at-risk. The agencies include but are not limited to Boys Town, Girls Home, other residential facilities for youth or other youth related agencies. The Internship Grant will help to supplement Social Work students' field placement allowance.

The disbursement of the first grant is expected to commence in AY2020/21.

Application Period

Applications will be open for 3 weeks in July with an announcement to students.

Value of Award

The Internship Grant is a one-time award of S\$1,500 per person per year.

Disbursement

The Internship Grant will be disbursed to students at the end of placement.

Eligibility

Students are required to submit a 2-page statement of his/her desire to work with at-risk youth, past experiences and reflection, and must meet the following eligibility conditions:

- Singapore Citizen or Singapore Permanent Resident; Obtained a
- GPA of 3.5; and
- Undertaking internship/placement working with youth-at-risk.

Application Process

Students are required to complete an application form and also upload the 2-page statement and other supporting documents.

Upon Successful Application

Successful applicants will be notified by email and requested to submit the acceptance form.
