

Providing individuals with the **VOICE** for them to tell their story; who they are and what are their hopes and aspirations.



Understanding their sense of **BELONGING**; relationships that matter to them and their network of support.



Giving them the **CHOICE** and options to choose what they want for themselves.

Working in tandem to build the company's growth





Belonging Victor's Story




Understanding who is most important in his life helped to point the direction towards his motivation.



Providing the opportunity for him to address his immediate needs in providing for his son.




