About the Course

The practice of social work involves ethical decision making. When dealing with an ethical conflict, social workers must determine which ethical principles take precedence, as well as consider clients' values, institutional policies and legislations. The profession's Code of Ethics provides guidance in various situations but is not designed for complex ethical situations. Instead, social workers must rely on ethical reasoning. This didactic and interactive course emphasizes ethical reasoning as a cornerstone in social work ethical decision-making. It aims to equip social workers with foundational ethical theories and decision-making frameworks to guide them in ethical reasoning and decision-making.
