

## Master of Social Work Tuition Fee Structure Singapore Citizens and Singapore Permanent Residents

### 1) Acceptance Fee

Acceptance Fee: S\$5,400 (inclusive of GST). This is a one-time payment upon acceptance of offer. The acceptance fee is non-refundable. It will be used to offset against the tuition fees for the first semester. Should there be any balance amount after the first semester's deduction, it can be used to offset the fees in the second semester.

### 2) Course Fees

Full-time and part-time Singaporean/Singapore Permanent Resident students will be billed based on the number of courses read per semester.
