TWO ADMISSION ROUTES

Direct Admission Route

For all applicants

Apply directly to the MSW and complete 40 units.

Stackable Route

For Singapore Citizens & Permanent Residents only

1. Complete one or more standalone courses first.
2. Apply to the MSW and stack eligible courses which you have completed, towards the 40 units.
3. Upon admission, complete the remaining courses.



ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor in Social Work or Graduate Diploma in Social Work or five years of work experience in social services.
- **GRE test NOT required.**



TYPICAL DURATION

- Full-time: 1.5 years
- Part-time: 2.5 years



PROGRAMME STRUCTURE*

- 40 units comprising: 3 core courses, 2 capstone courses, and 5 elective courses.
- Courses cover direct practice, policy & legislation, research & evaluation, and leadership.

APPLICATION TIMELINE



*Students are required to complete 40 units with a min. GPA of 3.0 to graduate.
