We also do not map General Education modules, EC2204, EC2205 and EC3305. We will not map above modules to dummy code too.

GE	The Department will not map GE1101E	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (5MC) can be transferred. Remaining 35MCs should be completed at NUS.	GE2101 and GE3240 Dummy codes cannot be used to fulfil your sub-disciplinary areas. (Social/Cultural, Politics, Economies and Space and Tropical Environmental Change)
GL	The convenor will generally not map GL1101E.	A maximum of two level 4000 modules (10MC) can be transferred. Task Force and remaining MCs should be completed at NUS.	
HY and EU	The Department will allow for the mapping of HY1101E and EU1101E on a case by case basis.	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (5MC) can be transferred. Remaining 35MCs should be completed at NUS. (For students on a one year exchange, one additional level 4000 module may be mapped. This is on a case by case basis.)	HY2259
JS	The Department will not allow students to map JS1101E.	The Department will allow students to map to JS4000 modules in extraordinary conditions, for example if a student is taking a graduate level modules at the partner university.	JS1101E, JS2101, JS3101
MS	The Department will not allow students to fulfil the Malay Studies exposure module abroad.	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (5MC) can be transferred. Remaining 35MCs should be completed at NUS.	MS4101

PL	As the Department requires all students who intend to major in PL to obtain at least a B-grade in PL1101E; this means that prospective PL majors may <u>not</u> map PL1101E. However, the Department will continue to allow PL1101E mapping for students <u>who do not intend to major in PL</u> .	A maximum of two level 4000 modules (10MC) can be transferred.
