- Offering a choice of six Majors Economics, English Literature, Geography, History, Political Science and Global Studies




Purpose of Joint Degree

- Enhanced educational experience
- Complementary nature of programme structure and contents of courses
 - UNC has extensive General Education programme
 - NUS has intensive Major programme
- Integrated study abroad (2 semesters)
- Experience of two systems
- Dual certification
- Collaborative teaching and learning

General Education Requirements

Foundations

- English Composition and Rhetoric
- Quantitative Reasoning

Approaches

- Physical and Life Sciences
- Social and Behavioral Sciences
- Humanities and the Fine Arts

Connections

- Foundations across the Curriculum
- Local, National and Global Connections

Higher Level General Education

- Outside major and not offered by major department
- Any module 2000 and above or >199



General Education Requirements

- Exempted for all pillars except for Computational Thinking
- NUS General Education modules done can be used to meet requirements of JDP



USP and Residential College

- JDP programme curriculum is paramount
- All other programme requirements such as USP and Residential College are secondary
- Students need to manage their studies if they want to be in these programmes
- JDP requirements will NOT be changed to suit the curriculum requirements of these other programmes
- They may be over and above the JDP degree requirements



Admission

- One of the 6 majors
- Read 1101E of the intended major
- Minimum CAP of 4.0
- Intent to pursue Honours



Title and Certificate

- Compulsory Honours programme for NUS students
- Optional Honours programme for UNC students
- Honours track
 - NUS students can get Bachelor of Arts with Hons by both institutions IF both UNC and NUS requirements are fulfilled
 - UNC students can get Bachelor of Arts with Hons from NUS and Bachelor of Arts with Hons from UNC IF both UNC and NUS honours requirements are fulfilled
- Crests and official signatures of both universities
