Hochstadt Scholarship in the Humanities

The Hochstadt Scholarship in The Humanities was set up by Mr Herman Ronald Hochstadt to commemorate the Hochstadt family in Singapore past and present, in particular those who were graduates of the University of Malaya and the National University of Singapore.

The purpose of the Scholarship is to award scholarships to students from the Faculty, who major in Humanities subjects. Humanities subjects include English Language, English Literature, Theatre Studies, History and Philosophy.

The award of this scholarship commenced in AY2014-15 with the award of up to five scholarships in each academic year, one from each of the Humanities subjects.

From AY2018-19, the scholarship was offered as an entrance scholarship for outstanding incoming students to the Faculty. Entrance scholarship candidates would be offered the scholarships at the point of being offered admission to the Faculty. From AY2019-20, the scholarship is extended to the Philosophy, Politics and Economics (PPE) Programme.

From AY2021-22, with the establishment of the College of Humanities and Sciences (CHS), the entrance scholarship will be converted to a mid-stream scholarship for Year 3 students with majors in Humanities subjects in English Literature, English Language, Theatre Studies, History, Philosophy and PPE. Up to six Scholarships may be awarded in each academic year.

The Scholarship is open to Year 3 students majoring in Humanities subjects in English Language, English Literature, Theatre Studies, History, Philosophy or PPE.

The Scholarship will cover the Year 3 tuition fees (excluding the MOE Tuition Grant), tenable for 1 year only.
