

Victor Seah Yun Zhen Bursary

Gifts of donations amounting to \$208,505 were made to the Faculty to establish an endowed bursary in memory of Dr Victor Seah Yun Zhen. The purpose of the gift is to provide a bursary for needy students from the faculty.

Dr Victor Seah's father, Seah Siok Kwang JP was a lifelong dedicated community leader and amongst one of the earliest awardees of the Public Service Star BBM. Dr Seah continued that legacy and devoted much of his life delivering community service and charity, often times providing free healthcare to help the poor and sick. Dr Seah was also one of the earliest pioneers in Singapore of integrative and functional medicine that advocate a holistic approach to health and wellness. His passion, devotion and focus on overall health and wellness rather than just orthodox disease-care, enriched the lives of family members, friends and patients over his 40+ years of medical practice.

The award of this bursary commenced in AY2020-21.
