2. Online Application Period

- a. Online application link: Apply here.
- b. Application Note:
 - Applicants are to follow the instructions carefully before proceeding with the application.
 - Applicants will be issued with a temporary registration number.
 - Applicants are allowed to save and close the application, and re-log in to the portal at a later time to complete the form.
 - In the application form under [STUDENT CATEGORY], applicants should select "Singapore University-SEP" and the home university name from the drop-down list.

3. Supporting Document

• Submission of hardcopy documents is not required. Applicants should get ready softcopies of their photograph and latest transcript to be uploaded during application.

IMPORTANT:

- a. Exchange students are encouraged to apply for 10 courses at application stage, regardless of the exchange mode (full/partial). This is to allow for flexibility during the course registration as there is no guarantee that the courses will have available vacancies and will not have timetable or exam clashes. NTU does not re-schedule class schedule and examination date for such reasons.
- b. Course approval and allocation are subject to meeting pre-requisites and vacancies availability.
- c. Some NTU courses are extremely popular and allocation cannot be guaranteed. Please click here to check for courses with restriction or limited vacancies before submitting the course selection.
- d. Only approved courses may be allocated. The allocation of approved courses will be completed by early January 2022.
- e. Semester workload at NTU:
 - o Partial exchange: minimum 1 course
 - Full exchange: maximum of 6 courses or 20 AUs
