

 - Student must be in good standing and recommended by home university
- 3. Official transcript or grade report in English from home university
- 4. TOEFL or IELTS score report
 - TOEFL 550 (paper), 80 (iBT), 214 (CBT), 6.5 (IELTS)
- 5. Medical History and Immunization Forms
- 6. Course Request Form
- 7. On-Campus Housing Application (online after acceptance)
- 8. Copy of Passport (submit with online DS-2019 Request Form after acceptance)
- 9. Certificate of Finances
 - Submit upon request after acceptance
