

Annie Tan (Mrs Wan Boo Sow) Bursary

In 2018, the Annie Tan (Mrs Wan Boo Sow) Bursary was established with the purpose of providing bursaries for undergraduates at the Department of Chinese Studies, Department of Malay Studies and Department of Southeast Asian Studies. The bursary will support one new student majoring in Chinese Studies/ Chinese Language, Malay Studies or Southeast Asian Studies in each academic year. The bursary commenced in AY2019-2020.

In 2021, the number of bursaries to be awarded was increased to up to 15 bursaries in each academic year, with up to 5 students from each of the abovementioned majors. A flexible bursary quantum of up to \$5000 per student may be awarded. These changes will take effect from AY2022-2023.

The bursary is valued up to \$5000 per academic year. The bursary is tenable for the remaining duration of the recipients' respective undergraduate course subject to annual review that the recipient continues to meet the eligibility requirements and other criteria for the award of the bursary.
