	<p><b>Bachelors and/or Masters certificate or degree scroll</b> (with English translation if applicable)</p> <p>Graduates from local universities can upload the Opencerts file with their online application</p>
	<p><b>* Bachelors and/or Masters degree transcript/result slip</b> (with English translation if applicable)</p> <p>You can submit photocopies of your result slip(s) or official/unofficial transcript(s) of your academic records. It is important to ensure that the university's grading scheme is included in the scanned copy of your result slip(s)/transcript(s).</p> <p>Graduates from local universities can upload the Opencerts file with their online application.</p> <p>NUS students can submit their unofficial transcript(s).</p>
	<p><b>TOEFL/IELTS</b> scoresheet (if any)</p>
	<p><b>GRE</b> scoresheet (if any)</p> <p>GRE is compulsory for Masters applicants to Political Science, Psychology &amp; Social Work only and PhD applicants to all FASS departments.</p>
	<p>* Recommendations from <b>two academic referees</b>.</p> <p>If either one of your academic referees is your potential thesis advisor, you are <u>strongly encouraged</u> to submit a third referee's report.</p> <p>The recommendations from the two academic referees are to be submitted directly via the online admission system.</p>
	<p>* <b>Research proposal</b> of at least two pages on A4-size paper. Some departments require a personal statement instead. Please refer to the website(s) of the department(s) you are applying to.</p>
	<p>Documentary <b>evidence of financial support</b></p> <p><u>Self-financing international applicants</u> must submit documentary evidence of financial support in the form of a bank statement and letter of confirmation from a sponsor (if statement not in candidate's name) or documentary evidence of scholarship or other award obtained.</p>
	<p><b>Other document(s)</b> (if any) (E.g. application form for the Joint PhD programmes, HYI-NUS Joint Doctoral Scholarship, FASS Scholarship in Buddhist Studies, etc.)</p>
