	Graduates from local universities can upload the Opencerts file with their online application
	*Bachelors and/or Masters degree transcript/result slip (with English translation if applicable)
	You can submit photocopies of your result slip(s) or official/unofficial transcript(s) of your academic records. It is important to ensure that the university's grading scheme is included in the scanned copy of your result slip(s)/transcript(s).
	Graduates from local universities can upload the Opencerts file with their online application.
	NUS students can submit their unofficial transcript(s).
	TOEFL/IELTS scoresheet (if any)
	GRE scoresheet (if any)
	GRE is compulsory for Masters applicants to Political Science, Psychology & Social Work only and PhD applicants to all FASS departments.
	*Recommendations from two academic referees.
	If either one of your academic referees is your potential thesis advisor, you are strongly encouraged to submit a third referee's report.
	The recommendations from the two academic referees are to be submitted directly via the online admission system.
	*Research proposal of at least two pages on A4-sze paper. Some departments require a personal statement instead. Please refer to the website(s) of the department(s) you are applying to.
	Documentary evidence of financial support
	<u>Self-financing international applicants</u> must submit documentary evidence of financial support in the form of a bank statement and letter of confirmation from a sponsor (if statement not in candidate's name) or documentary evidence of scholarship or other award obtained.
	Other document(s) (if any) (E.g. application form for the Joint PhD programmes, HYI-NUS Joint Doctoral Scholarship, FASS Scholarship in Buddhist Studies, etc.)
