

### Policy on mapping exposure and level 4000 modules by Departments

2	CNM	The Department will not map NM1101E.	A maximum of two level 4000 modules (8 MC) can be transferred. Remaining 12 MCs should be completed at NUS.	All NM Core Modules (NM2101, NM2103, NM2104) and NM4102 For other modules, the department generally will only approve mapping to department dummy codes, eg. NM174X, NM274X, NM374X and NM475X.  Students are encouraged to avoid mapping modules which are pre-requisites of other modules they intend to read in the future.
3	EC	The Department will not map EC1101E.	The Department will not map level 4000 courses.	All EC compulsory modules (EC1101E, EC1301, EC2101, EC2102, EC2104, EC2303, EC3101, EC3102, EC3303, EC3304) and EC4000/5000R modules. We also do not map General Education modules, EC2204, EC2205, EC3305 and SEP modules which combine International Trade and International Finance into one module (eg International Economics). We will not map above modules to dummy code too.
4	ELL	The Department will not normally map modules to EL/EN/TS1101E but under special circumstances will allow mapping to EL/EN/TS1101E.	The Department will not normally map modules to 4000 level, but under special circumstances will allow mapping to a maximum of <b>one 4000-level</b> module for each student.	
5	GE	The Department will not map GE1101E	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (4MC) can be transferred. Remaining 16MCs should be completed at NUS.	GE2101 /GE2102 /GE2103 /GE2215 /GE2231 and GE3240
6	GL	The convenor will generally not map GL1101E. There might be very exceptional circumstances where it may be possible.	The convenor will allow mapping of 4000-level modules (10 MC) as replacements or additions to honours seminars, but not for Task Forces. The mapping will be on the basis of the level and content of the class.	Task Force
7	HY	The Department will allow for the mapping of HY1101E on a case by case basis (particularly for students who return from SEP after studying an exposure-type module and decide they want to take up a HY major).	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (4 MC) can be transferred. Remaining 16 MCs should be completed at NUS.	The Department will not map: HY2259 AH2101 (Art History minor students)

10	PH	The Department will continue to allow non-major students only to map GET1029	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (4 MC) can be transferred. Remaining 16 MCs should be completed at NUS.	
11	PL	Students are allowed to map PL1101E.	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (4 MC) can be transferred. Remaining 16 MCs should be completed at NUS.  <i>*subject to the proviso that the module should at least be reasonably classified as level-4000 or equivalent, and should be a psychology module. The approval is based on a number of factors, including 1) the topic of the module, 2) difficulty level as described by the partner university, 3) mode of delivery of the module, 4) class size, 5) number of prerequisites, 6) continuous assessment components, and 7) detailed description of the syllabus. Students should not assume that a module at the partner university that meets some of these factors (e.g., the title of the module or class size) can be mapped automatically.</i>	Mapping to PL2131 is allowed. However, mapping to PL2132, PL3231, PL3551 and lab modules is not allowed.  L4000 PL dummy codes cannot be used to fulfil the following: Capstone group, Biological, Cognitive and Developmental group and Abnormal/Clinical, Social and Applied group

12	PS	The Department will not map PS1101E	A maximum of two level 4000 modules (8 MC) can be transferred. Remaining 12 MCs should be completed at NUS.	The Department will not map PS3257 Political Inquiry.
13	SAS	The Department will map SN1101E if suitable.	A maximum of two level 4000 modules (8 MC) can be transferred. Remaining 12 MCs should be completed at NUS.	
14	SC/AN	The Department will not map SC1101E and AN1101E.	All L4000 should be completed at NUS	All SC and AN compulsory modules
15	SEAD	Mapping of SE1101E is not allowed.	A maximum of one level 4000 module (4 MCs) can be transferred. Remaining 16 MCs should be completed at NUS.	
16	SWK	The Department will not map SW1101E	A maximum of one level 4000 modules (4MC) can be transferred. Remaining 16MCs should be completed at NUS.	All SWK compulsory modules will not be mapped; For SWK elective modules, department will generally only approve mapping to department dummy codes, e.g. SW27xx, SW37xx, SW47xx, etc.
17	PPE	NA	One 4000-level module (4MC) may be mapped from a module read while on exchange, subject to the owning department's approval. A second 4000-level module may be mapped if the need arises (please write in to specialization department with your justification). To map the exchange module mapped to a specific module code, write to the owning department (e.g. to map PE4101P, write to PH). If you want your exchange module mapped to a dummy code, write to the specialization department. In both cases, provide information about the prospective module's syllabus to show that it is PPE relevant.
