- S\$50 per application [inclusive of GST, applicable to the rest of coursework programmes]

Payment by Post

Payment by post can be made by either a **cheque or bankdraft** drawn on a bank in Singapore and made payable to '**National University of Singapore**'. The cheque or bankdraft should have the **sender's name, mailing address and programme applied for written on the reverse side**.

Personal cheques (should be crossed) are accepted only from candidates in Singapore. Foreign applicants are requested to send bankdraft and **not** personal cheques. Please **DO NOT** send cash by post. Please forward cheques/bankdrafts to the respective department of the programme applying for.
