

Tan Keong Choon and Tan Keng Hean Scholarship

Ms Tan Cheng Han, a property developer and Director of SC Land which owns and manages several projects in Australia, donated \$200,000 to establish an endowment fund for a Scholarship in honour of her father, Mr Tan Keong Choon and her grandfather, Mr Tan Keng Hean. Mr Tan Keong Choon was a prominent Chinese business and community leader. He made significant contributions to the rubber industry in Singapore and was a well-respected leader in the business and education community. He served several terms as President and Vice-President of the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce and Industry and was Chairman of Chinese High and Hwa Chong JC Management Committees. Mr Tan Keong Choon's father, Mr Tan Keng Hean was the younger brother of Mr Tan Kah Kee. The elder Mr Tan helped in his brother's rubber business. He also built and managed schools in China.

The purpose of the Fund is to award Scholarships to FASS undergraduates who are academically strong and financially needy.

The award of the Scholarship commenced in AY2018-19.

The Scholarship is open to Year 3 and Year 4 students from any FASS major. For students with FASS second majors, their first home faculty must be FASS. Applicants should have excellent results, strong leadership qualities and potential and good co-curricular activities record. Financial needs would be taken into consideration

The Scholarship is valued at \$5000 and is tenable for one year only.

Successful applicants may apply again for the scholarship the following year, if they meet the eligibility requirements.
