With the increase in global trade and capital flows, understanding and managing foreign exchange market exposures are important skills in the workplace. These include the choice of exchange rate regimes, exchange rate forecasting and exposure management using a variety of instruments, and policies to ensure the smooth functioning of the foreign exchange markets.
