Mr and Mrs Ngiam Fook Quee Memorial Scholarship

The Mr and Mrs Ngiam Fook Quee Scholarship was set up in memory of the parents of the Ngiam family. NUS alumni Ngiam Tong Dow, Ngiam Tong Lan, Ngiam Shih Chun, Ngiam Siew Pei, Ngiam Siew Ching Selina, Goh Suh Fang and Goh Boon Han together with eight other family members – Ngiam Tong Yuen, Ngiam Shih Kwang Kelvin, Ngiam Shih Tung, Ngiam Siew Wei, Ngiam Siew Ying, Ngiam Tong Tau, Ngiam Shih Ern and Goh Boon Kiat – joined hands to contribute to the Fund.

From AY2021/22, with the establishment of the College of Humanities and Sciences (CHS), the Scholarship was changed to be offered to Year 2 students studying Economics, Social Work, and the Philosophy, Politics and Economics (PPE) programme. Up to 4 Scholarships may be given out in each academic year, one each from Economics, Social Work, PPE, and another from any of the three majors. The Scholarship will cover the successful candidates' tuition fees from their second year until the Honours year.

From AY2022/23, the award may be opened to either of the other two listed majors in the event that there are no suitable candidates from any of the majors. Additional awards may also be given to candidates subject to sufficient spending limit after the 4 awards have been awarded.

From AY2023/24, up to 6 Scholarships may be given out in each academic year, one each from Economics, Social Work, and PPE, and the remaining 3 Scholarships may be given to students from any of the three majors. In the event there are insufficient suitable candidates from any one of the majors, the selection of candidate(s) may then be opened to the other two listed majors.

From AY2026/27, the Scholarship will be awarded as full and entrance Scholarships. Up to 3 full Scholarships may be given to students from the 3 eligible majors/programmes to cover their tuition fees from their second year until the Honours year, while one-time entrance Scholarships valued at \$4,000 each will be awarded to incoming students selected from applicants who have been interviewed by the admission scholarship committee at the Faculty. The number of entrance Scholarships is dependent on available spending limit.
