Exchange model	Fee-waiver semester exchange for students from SUSS partner universities. Students continue to pay the applicable tuition/course fees to their home institution.

	Students are responsible for any applicable miscellaneous, activity, administrative, and other fees payable to SUSS or other relevant parties.
Study mode	Students may take undergraduate courses offered university-wide, including both daytime and evening courses. Course restrictions may apply. Please refer to the “SUSS Restricted Courses” list for details.
Workload	Up to 6 undergraduate courses / 30 Credit Units (CUs) per semester. Students must be enrolled in at least 1 SUSS course to remain in the programme. <i>Note: Most courses are allocated 5 CUs, while a small number of courses are allocated 2.5 CUs. Students are responsible for checking the CUs allocated to their selected and/or accepted courses.</i> <i>Note: Students who wish to take more than 6 courses or 30 CUs must submit an overload approval from their home university. If approved, students must ensure that there are no clashes in their class schedules or examination timetables.</i>
Language of instruction	English is the main medium of instruction, except for language/language-related courses conducted in other languages.
Accommodation	SUSS does not provide on- or off-campus accommodation. Students must arrange accommodation before arrival.

1. Eligibility & Academic Requirements

- Be an undergraduate student nominated by your home university.
- Have completed at least one semester of undergraduate study before enrolling at SUSS.
- Remain registered at your home university throughout the exchange period.
- Not be in your final year of study while on exchange at SUSS.
- Meet the minimum academic requirement of GPA 3.3 on a 5-point scale, unless otherwise agreed under the exchange arrangement.
- Have sufficient English proficiency to follow lessons and complete coursework.
- Meet any prerequisites for courses selected; SUSS may request supporting documents where required.

2. English Proficiency

International students fully matriculated in a local university for tertiary education whose prior qualifications were not taught in English are required to submit supporting evidence of English proficiency.

Students must meet one of the following English language requirements:

- IELTS Academic: minimum 6.5
- TOEFL iBT: minimum 85
- MUET: minimum Band 4.0
- PTE Academic: minimum 58
- C1 Advanced: minimum 180

Validity of Test Scores

- IELTS, TOEFL, PTE Academic and C1 Advanced scores must have been obtained within the last 2 years at the point of admission.
- MUET scores must have been obtained within the last 5 years at the point of admission.
- All test results must be submitted to the Global Learning Team at the point of application.

If you do not have one of the above certificates:

You may submit a Declaration Letter of English Proficiency endorsed by a professor or the International Office of your home university.

3. Application & Admission

4. Course Selection & Registration

- Nominated students will receive an email from the Global Learning Team with a link to the online Application Form.
- Students are encouraged to select at least 6 courses for a partial SUSEP*, or up to 15 courses for a full SUSEP*, during the application period. Students should rank their courses according to priority.
- Students should **select** at least 3 courses and up to 15 courses in case of timetable or examination clashes. As course places are not guaranteed, selecting more courses according to priority is recommended to ensure you are offered sufficient courses during course selection.
- Changes to course selection after submission may be considered on a case-by-case basis.
- As an inbound student, you must be enrolled in at least 1 SUSS course (5 CUs) per semester, with a maximum course load of 6 courses (30 CUs) per semester.
- Courses approved during the application period may not run during the semester due to low enrolment or other reasons. Students should take this into consideration when planning their course selection.

**Partial SUSEP refers to an exchange where students take courses at both home university and SUSS; Full SUSEP refers to an exchange where students take all courses at SUSS.*

5. Course Restrictions

- Inbound students are only permitted to enroll in courses designed for undergraduates.
- Undergraduate courses have course codes that should fall within the 100 – 400 level (e.g. FIN205, BUS362 and FIN415), excluding courses listed in the “SUSS Restricted Courses” document.
- Students should refer to the attached “SUSS Restricted Courses” document for course restrictions. The document may be updated as and when required.

6. Credit Transfer and Transcript Issuance

- During application period: Students may refer to the SUSS [CourseFinder](#) to review course outlines when assessing credit transfer.
- Pre-exchange period: Students are responsible for ensuring that the SUSS courses selected are transferable for credit at their home university.
- Post-exchange period: Exam results will be released on 18 May 2027. Students may refer to the [2027 Academic Calendar](#).
- Transcript Issuance period: End-July to mid-August

7. Fees

SUSS Registration Fee	Waived under the exchange arrangement.
Course Fees	SUSEP is a fee-waiver exchange programme. Visiting students pay tuition/course fees to their home institution and receive a waiver of tuition fees at SUSS.
Other, Miscellaneous Fees	There may be other applicable administrative fees and additional charges, such as course activities fees, course material fees etc. Where applicable, students will be informed in due course. You will be subject to a nominal administration fee of \$100.00 (there will be an additional 9% GST at point of billing) if you wish to withdraw from a course <i>more than two weeks after the semester commences.</i>

8. Insurance

Exchange students must have comprehensive health insurance with their home university. Students are required to submit the insurance policy and relevant supporting documents as proof of coverage. SUSS does not provide travel insurance for visiting students.

9. Accommodation

SUSS does not provide on- or off-campus accommodation.

10. SUSS Orientation Day

SUSS organises an Orientation Day packed with activities for incoming students. The Global Learning team will provide participating inbound exchange students with the relevant details, including date, time and joining instructions. All inbound students are welcome to campus for the orientation prior to commencement of the semester.

Visiting Students on Inbound Student Semester Exchange

Important Course Registration Restrictions for all inbound students

Note: All applicants for SUSS Inbound Semester Exchange must be matriculated students at their respective home universities or institutes.

1. SUSS' courses are coded in the following convention: Course Abbreviation + Digit for Course Level + Assigned Course number. The first digit in the course code denotes the level of the course. For example, BUS103 indicates a Level 1 Business course.

Note that:

- **Courses coded with 10X – 40X** are *undergraduate courses*.
- **Courses coded with 50X and above** are *graduate courses (NOT open to inbound undergraduates)*.

2. All post-graduate courses under the Graduate Studies programmes (**Graduate Diploma, Master and Doctor programmes**) are **NOT** open to inbound students on Semester Exchange. Course codes under these programmes typically range from Level 50X to Level 60X, with a small handful of Level 40X courses falling under the Master programmes.

3. ALL courses from the School of Law are **NOT** open to inbound students on Semester Exchange.

- Graduate Diploma in Taxation: Courses are prefixed with "TAX"
- Master of Taxation: Courses are prefixed with "TAX"
- Bachelor of Law: Courses are prefixed with "LAW"
- Juris Doctor: Courses are prefixed with "LAW"

4. All courses from the following Undergraduate study programmes are **NOT** open to inbound students on Semester Exchange:

- a. Bachelor of Early Childhood Education (with Minor): Courses are prefixed with "ECE"
Note: This is applicable to BOTH Full-Time and Part-Time Early Childhood Education programmes.
- b. Bachelor of Early Childhood and Chinese Language Education (学前华文教育学士学位)
Note: Courses are prefixed with "ECC" and "ECL"
- c. Bachelor of Social Work (Full-Time): Courses are prefixed with "SWK"
Note: This is applicable to BOTH Full-Time and Part-Time Social Work programmes.
- d. BA Tamil Language and Literature: Courses are prefixed with "TLL"

5. Requests for any courses not listed in the course offerings and/or course mentioned in this document will **NOT** be granted as they are not available for the semester exchange programme. All appeals for approval will **NOT** be entertained.

Note: Some courses offered at point of course selection period may not be available towards the course confirmation period due to low enrollment rates.

6. Request for LAB-based courses are **subject to the approval**. SUSS reserves the right to review and/or reject any requests for courses that involve lab sessions. All appeals for approval will **NOT** be entertained.

7. All Undergraduate courses with course codes prefixed with:

- “NCO”,
- “NIE”,
- “CDO”,
- “ETB”,
- “SDE”,
- “ECE”/“ECL”/“ECC”, and
- “SWK”.

Are not listed in the course offering and strictly **NOT** open to inbound students.

8. The following courses are **NOT** included in the course offering as they are **NOT** open to inbound students.

- ANL321;
- BUS490;
- MKT498;
- MKT499;
- NIE499;
- BIS388;
- COU-coded courses;
- All courses that involve international travelling;
- HBC105;
- HBC215;
- LOG223; and
- VIS251

9. Approval for courses prefixed with “ACC” will be considered on case-by-case basis only if applicants have prior knowledge or background in accounting that meet the pre-requisites of the accountancy courses. SUSS reserves the right to decline students’ course requests.

10. Approval for courses prefixed with “BSE” will be considered on case-by-case basis only if applicants have prior knowledge or background in physical education that meet the pre-requisites of the BSE- courses. SUSS reserves the right to decline students’ course requests.

11. Approval for courses prefixed with “FMT” will be considered on case-by-case basis only if applicants have

prior knowledge or background in buildings and/or building services that meet the pre-requisites of the FMT- courses. SUSS reserves the right to decline students' course requests.

12. Courses with pre-requisites may or may not be open to inbound students, hence interested applicants who decide to apply for such courses should have the supporting documents ready to verify their eligibility for the course.
13. Inbound students should understand that they may not eventually be successful in their request for a particular course or courses even if they are able to produce proof of fulfilment of pre-requisites.
14. External courses that come with additional costs and/or are not conducted within SUSS premises are **NOT** offered to inbound students.
15. Students who wish to take MLL181 Malay Language for Work 1 should have basic background knowledge of the Malay language, for example, proficient enough to be able to maintain a (daily) conversation.

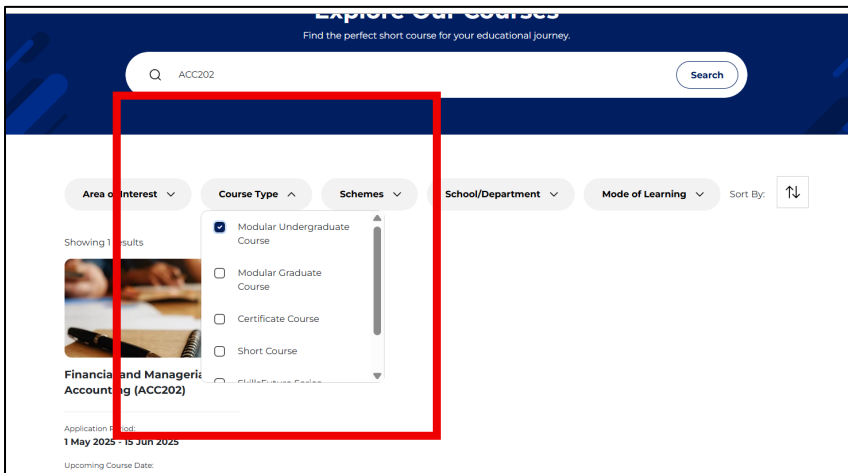
Note: Students should **NOT** hold formal qualifications like the "A" and/or "O" Levels Certificate for Malay language.

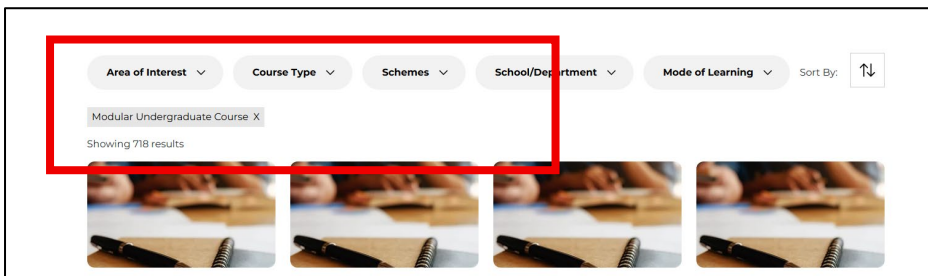

Method 1: Using CourseFinder

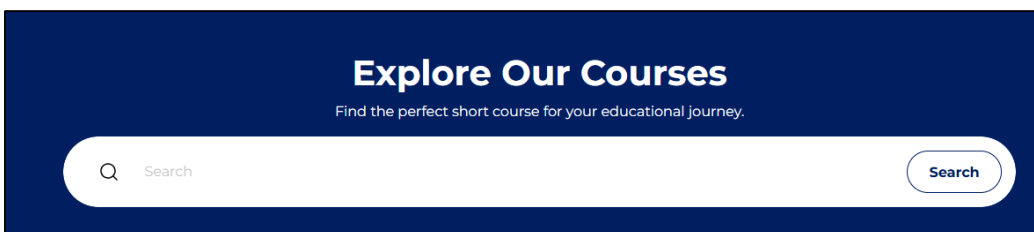
1. Apply the filter under **Course Type**: Modular Undergraduate Course



2. Ensure the filter is applied **before searching** for course outlines.



3. Set the filter to **“Undergraduate Modular Courses”** to view courses available for **inbound semester exchange students**. Enter the course code or course title in the Search field.

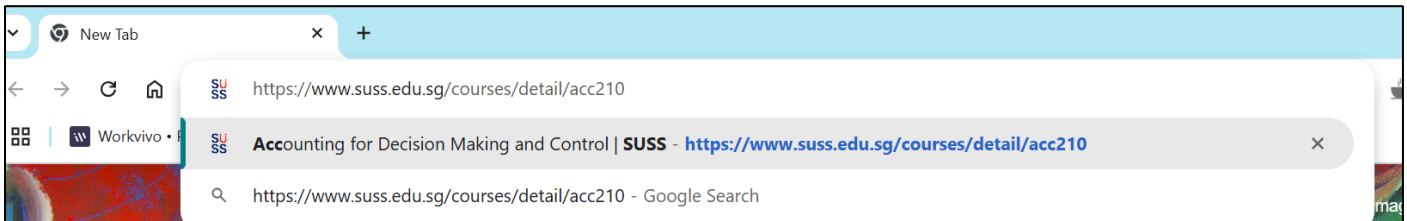


Method 2: Direct Link to Course Outline

1. Scroll to the **bottom of the course page**.
2. Click **“Full-time Programmes”** or **“Part-Time Programmes / CET Courses”** to download the PDF.
